## 2018 Swine Show Rules

- 1. All exhibitors are required to read the "General Rules and Regulations."
- 2. All entry applications must be completed and submitted with full name, address, social security number and age of contestant as of September 1, 2018.
- 3. All swine must come from Pseudorabies-free states or herd, or be blood tested negative. Animals must be accompanied by a house certificate. Animals may not be unloaded until proper health papers are checked. Any animals showing illness may be dismissed from the Fair.
- 4. Swine exhibitors will be furnished shavings for bedding their pens. Food will not be provided. All tack will be kept in the tack area.
- 5. Exhibits and walkways adjacent to the exhibits must be kept clean, neat, swept and dry.
- 6. Exhibitors shall be limited to two entries in any one class.
- 7. Exhibitors shall be neatly attired, preferably in traditional show ring apparel, when they appear in the Show Ring. (White pants and white shirts). Exhibitors shall exemplify courtesy to the judge,
  - ring master, ring attendants and fellow exhibitors when handling their animals in the Show Ring.

- 8. SMOKING IN THE BARN OR SHOW RING IS PROHIBITED.
- 9. The Hebron Harvest Fair will award ribbons to the exhibitors whose exhibits place in the money placings of all classes.
- 10. Arrival and departure swine may arrive in the grounds by 7:30 p.m., Thursday, September 8th, and may not leave the grounds until 5:30 p.m. on Sunday, September 13th.
- 11. Animals will be fed and cared for by the contestant. Pens must be cleaned on Sunday.
- 12. The superintendent of live stock reserves the right to reject any swine entry if it deems advisable.
- 13. Classes may be changed at the discretion of the superintendent.
- 14. Unnecessary rough handling of any pig will result in immediate disqualification from the show or from the Hebron Harvest Fair.
- 15. Premiums will be mailed before October 1, 2018
- 16. Premiums awarded may be liable to pro rata reductions sufficient to meet any deficiency that may occur.
